Siloam Baptist Church Community Scholarship Award

Introduction

The Siloam Baptist Church Community Scholarship Award is available to graduating high school seniors who attend Norristown, Colonial, Methacton, and Upper Merion school districts, including the vocational high schools within those districts. Eligibility will also include graduating high school students who reside in Norristown, but do not attend schools in the districts above.

The submission of an application does not automatically result in the award of a scholarship. This is a competitive process. To ensure that your application is included in the scholarship award competition, please read and comply with the instructions below.

Please note that the completed application and all attachments must be clean, neat, and legible.

A complete package must include the following:

- Part I – the Application – submit on or before the deadline shown below. Late applications will not be considered.
 - Applications can be obtained on the church website (www.siloambc.org), via e-mail (info@siloambc.org), or from the church office at 1329 Willow Street, Norristown, PA 19401, telephone 610-275-8163.
 - Complete the entire application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
 - Neatly type or write your full name on every page of the application.
- Part II – Transcript and Recommendations – submit to your school's college guidance counselor or other school official who is responsible for assisting students with college admissions. **This should be done immediately in order to allow enough time for documents to be received, reviewed, and attached to the application.**

- Two signed letters of recommendation – **not from relatives.**
 - One letter of recommendation must be from a school official (Ex. principal, counselor, teacher, dean, etc.).
 - The second letter must be from an adult who knows you well (Ex. coach, instructor, employer, counselor).
- An official sealed high school transcript mailed directly to the Siloam Baptist Church office, at the address on page 6.
- A letter of acceptance from the college/university you plan to attend.
- **A one to two page/s double spaced, using Times New Roman 12 point font, typed personal essay as specified on page 5 of the application. Be sure to include your full name at the top of the essay on each page and page of the application.**

It is best to work with the college guidance counselor to ensure that your application package has been completed and submitted in a timely manner.

The Decision Process: Awards will be based on the content of the essays, GPA, notable achievements, letters of recommendation, and church /community involvement. **Recipients will be notified by email or phone on or before May 27, 2025.** **If a selected scholarship recipient fails to respond to the telephone and/or email notification within five business days, the award will be forfeited.**

- **The entire completed scholarship package must be received in the church office no later than April 11, 2025.**
- **Application Packages that are incomplete or are received after this date/time will not be considered.**

The essay must be on a separate 8.5” x 11” sheet of plain bond, with your full name at the top page/s. Please be sure to type double space, using Times New Roman 12 point font. See attached essay rubric for guidelines to compose your essay.

Part II. Transcript and Recommendations -- To be completed by an authorized school official (i.e. principal, counselor, teacher, advisor, etc.)
